RE: IPRS Service Limits

Due to limited IPRS funding the following changes will be effective as of January 1, 2012, for all counties. This will bring all the counties operated under the PBH waiver toward having the same service array.

Service Code	Description	Action
MST	H2033	No new IPRS consumers, unless a part of JJMHSAP
IIHS	H2022	No new IPRS consumers, unless a part of JJMHSAP
Day Treatment	H2012-HA	No new IPRS consumers, consumers with existing authorization will be allowed to continue until end of the auth
CST	H2015HT	No new IPRS consumers during existing authorization period providers should determine if any consumers qualify for ACTT
Residential Level I	H0046	No new IPRS consumers, consumers with existing authorization will be allowed to continue until end of the auth
Residential Level II Family Type	S5145	No new IPRS consumers, consumers with existing authorization will be allowed to continue until end of the auth

Residential Level II Program Type	H2020	No new IPRS consumers, consumers with existing authorization will be allowed to continue until end of the auth
Residential Level III	H0019	No new IPRS consumers, consumers with existing authorization will be allowed to continue until end of the auth
Residential Level IV	H0019	No new IPRS consumers, consumers with existing authorization will be allowed to continue until end of the auth
Hourly Respite	YA125	No new IPRS consumers, consumers with existing authorization will be allowed to continue until end of the auth (if consumers have Medicaid should transition to B-3 Respite)
Community Respite	YA213	No new IPRS consumers, consumers with existing authorization will be allowed to continue until end of the auth (if consumers have Medicaid should transition to B-3 Respite)
Personal Assistance	YP020	No new IPRS consumers, consumers with existing authorization will be allowed to continue until end of the auth
Opioid Treatment	H0020	No new IPRS consumers, consumers with existing authorization will be allowed to continue until end of the auth

IPRS consumers will continue to have access to emergency services and medication services as needed.

We will review the impact of these changes on an ongoing basis to determine if these measures are working to maintain our state service costs within our budgetary limits.
